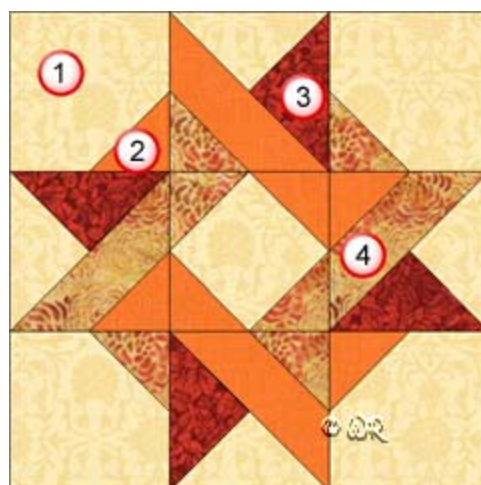
Sample Quilt Layouts

Cut 5 squares 4 1/2"

Cut 1 square 5 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals

Cut 6 squares 2 1/2"

Cut 1 square 4 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal

Cut 1 square 5 1/4"

and bisect on both diagonals

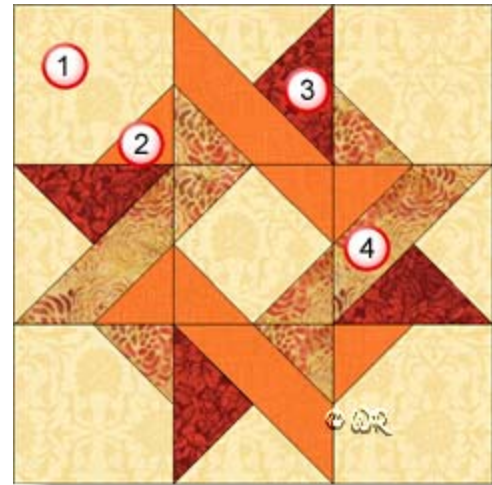

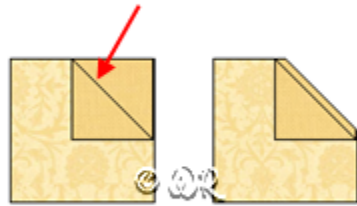

| 1 |  | Background fabric Cut 5 squares 2 1/2" Cut 1 square 3 3/4" and bisect on both diagonals |
| 2 |  | Fabric 2 Cut 6 squares 1 1/2" Cut 1 square 2 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal |
| 3 |  | Fabric 3 Cut 1 square 3 3/4" and bisect on both diagonals |
| 4 |  | Fabric 4 Cut 6 squares 1 1/2" Cut 1 square 2 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal |

Entwined Star

1

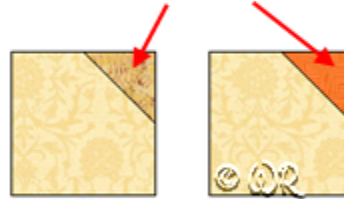
1. Draw pencil line corner to corner on small square (wrong side of fabric)

2. Sew on pencil line



3. Cut away excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line

Press toward corner



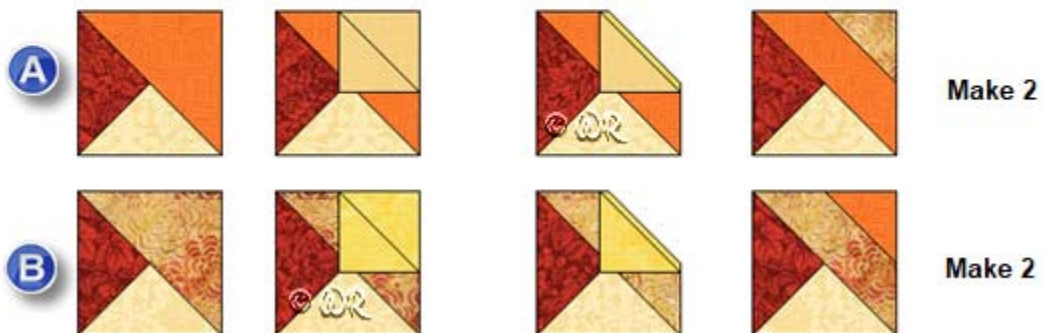

3 Centre Patch

Using method as in Step 1, add corner triangles to **opposite** corners

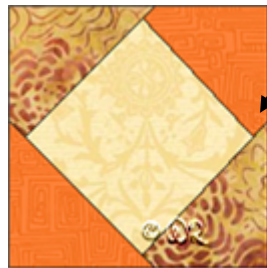


Using second fabric, add opposite corners



**** Important Sewing Note ****

Points of centre patch do not reach outer edge — leaving the seam allowance for next seam



Final centre patch should look like this -- ready for next seam
